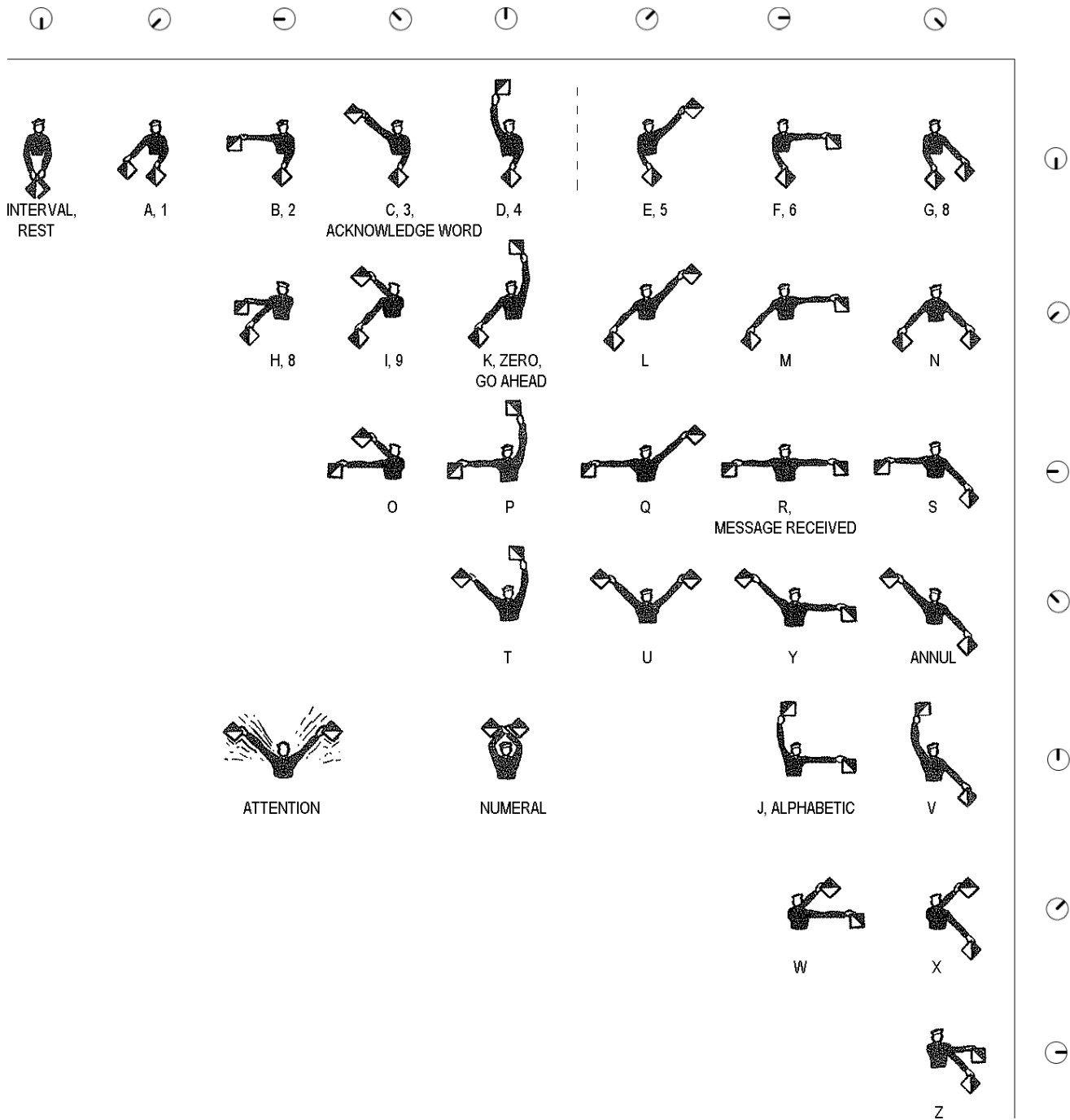


Flag semaphore signal schema



Messaging Sequence

Signaler	Action	Meaning
Sender:	<i>U</i> (waving)	Attention
Receiver:	<i>K</i>	Go ahead
Sender:	<i>B T</i>	Start message
	Sender spells out a word	
	Numeral interval	Change signaling to numbers
	<i>J</i> interval	Return signaling to letters
	<i>EEEEEEEE</i>	Error, will repeat word
	Rest interval	Word complete
Receiver:	<i>C</i>	Acknowledge word
	<i>I M</i>	Repeat word
Sender:	<i>A A A</i>	Period (end of sentence)
Both:	<i>A S</i>	Wait a moment
Sender:	<i>A R</i>	End of message
Receiver:	<i>R</i>	Message completely received

From the *Sea Scout Manual*:

"Form the letters by placing two flags at certain angles to each other. Hold each so that the staff is a continuation of your forearm. Keep your arms stiff.

Whenever you cross a flag in front of you to make a letter, twist your body slightly in the same direction."
